The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together. It is a third being. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity, as this relates to the meaning for each individual within it.

Introduction

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity.

In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

Funnel, focal planet Jupiter

You have the planetary pattern type called the 'funnel' shape (also known as the 'bucket'). All your planets form a group, with the exception of the focal point, one planet or two planets in conjunction (bucket handle). Your energies tend to be channeled through this focus. You will have abilities in the occupied area of the chart, and goals in the direction of the focal point. The focal planet(s) symbolizes how your energies will be expressed, and where you seek to have your needs met or achieve your purpose.

Jupiter in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will find mutual good fortune and faith in positive outcomes.

Jupiter in the Fourth House (or sign) magnifies the loving, kind and caring qualities within your relationship. Your connection with each other is likely to be friendly and sociable, generous and high-minded. You two have an instinct for nurturing others as well as yourselves, and find enjoyment, opportunity and growth in this type of tribal sharing. Together you may possess excellent executive abilities. You share an inherent spirituality, which is displayed not in philosophy, but in acts of love and kindness. You work well in partnership with the public, and attract material rewards without seeming to try for them. In a romantic relationship, you share a natural sense of security, and enjoy each other's family and your own if you have one together. You will have good luck with finding and maintaining a joyful and beneficial home environment. You may find that you bring out the best part of each other's relationship to your early conditioning. You may also find a sense of contentment in performing the simple chores around your shared environment. This relationship will undoubtedly help to expand the consciousness within each of you regarding your background and sense of security, and facilitates your shared exploration of the mystical and the marvelous side of life.

Composite Jupiter in Leo (or the fifth house) magnifies the generosity and vitality within your relationship and brings out your love of pleasure. In this relationship, you grow through the practice of manifesting your dreams. You two like to show off your good side, and have a natural flair and sense of showmanship that carries you far in life. You make an excellent entertaining team. In a romantic relationship, it pays to remain as aware as you can of the effects of egotism on the part of each of you. You may struggle competitively unless you realize the greater power of a more transpersonal approach. You enjoy the limelight as a couple, and do well when you shine out and share your wealth with those around you. As a partnership, you can be extravagant at times. You benefit when you learn to keep track of your resources and to build a strong foundation under your dreams, as these practices are essential to your success. Together, you have a great sense of intuition, and make capable leaders. Your true leadership in social circles may come when you begin to trust your inner guidelines and look outward to see what you can give rather than what you can get.

Grand Trine

You have a Grand Trine in your chart. When three or more of your planets form a Grand Trine with each other, you will have an exceptional area of talent represented by the element in the trine, either Fire, Earth, Air or Water (usually these planets are in just one element). You will display a marked self-sufficiency and also will have good success in your endeavors in this area of life. You must also beware, however, of being lazy or complacent.

Composite Mars in the Seventh House

Leading planet of planetary pattern

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

Mars in the Seventh House (or sign) brings out a sensitive and emotionally impressionable but powerful energy in your relationship. Together you have a strong drive to get involved with and to lead other people. You two are likely to be seen by others as epitomizing charm and poise. In this relationship, you can both be persuasive talkers, and are fond of getting your own way, but you are also truly committed to fairness for all parties to a dispute, and will go out of your way to make sure it happens. In a romantic context, you are likely to be rash and ardent lovers, and it is possible that you will commit to each other early on. You both may be attracted to the ideal of partnerships generally, and benefit from cultivating self-reliance. You might need to work through quarreling with each other and those around you as a way of standing up to being overly influenced. You benefit from cultivating moderation and objectivity in your dealings with each other, and when as a team you relate to others.

Composite Mars in Sagittarius (or the ninth house) brings a friendly and optimistic quality to the energy of this relationship, inspiring a spontaneous and impulsive drive for results. You tend to work well and joyfully together, with competition and jealousy at a minimum, although you are sometimes scattered in the application of your joint energies, and are perhaps best suited as a partnership in focusing on the big picture, and delegating the details. You are likely to explore sports or perhaps gambling when with each other. You tend to lead physically active lives together, and may find that the perfect day would be an outing in nature such as a hike rather than anything fancy. You two are idealistic, outspoken and honest with your opinions. You also have a synergistic propensity for growth, which makes this an ideal placement for joint learning and development, or for a student-teacher relationship. While your mutual perspective on the big picture comes easily, you benefit when you slow down, pay attention to details and concentrate your energies.

Composite Sun in Sagittarius (17° Sag 47' 29")
Composite Sun in the Seventh House
Angular planet - conjunct Descendant

The placement of the composite Sun defines the core identity of your relationship, and the place where it finds its greatest vitality. It gives you a sense of the predominant flavor of the relationship.

The composite Sun in the Seventh House indicates a relationship where each of you gain vitality from relating intimately with each other and with those around you. This is an excellent indicator for all type of partnership, and implies an active orientation toward fully sharing your goals and activities. In a romantic partnership, you keenly feel how this relationship can begin to flesh out your unconscious areas of self. You have an intuitive sense of what the partnership requires and a shared awareness that the sum here definitely adds up to something more than its parts. There may be a tendency for both of you and your individual identities to disappear within the shelter of the relationship, transforming both of you into something new. It is likely that you see in each other someone who reflects your deeper self, and that together, you will to gravitate toward others who reflect that same depth. In a more business-oriented partnership, you likely have much in common with your approach, and are willing to see the joint effort as more important than what you can accomplish individually. Whatever you seek to accomplish together has a good chance of positive results. You only need to be aware that there are in fact two individuals operating here, so as not to lose your individual perspectives in the shared effort.

With the composite Sun in Sagittarius, this relationship centers on the principals of freedom, expansion and exploration. You almost always know where you stand with each other, and those around you know where they do, too. Regardless of how you operate on your own, this relationship will bring out your direct, good-natured and optimistic side. Travel and educational or other higher mind pursuits come naturally to the two of you when you act in concert. In a romantic relationship, you two are likely to enjoy adventure, sports and travel, perhaps gambling and risk-taking. You may find you spend a lot of your shared time in nature, and easily tap into an enthusiasm that can be contagious to those around you. You are high minded as a couple while remaining fun-loving and full of laughter, even at your own expense. As a partnership you go for the adventure of life and foster a sense of honesty and truthfulness with each other. The world is your playground; mentally, physically and emotionally. At the highest level, this relationship is concerned with understanding and joy in the service of high ideals for the benefit of mankind.

Composite Neptune in Pisces (6° Pis 50')
Composite Neptune in the Tenth House

Neptune in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter idealization and nebulous spiritual feelings that will lead you to self-discovery.

Neptune in the Tenth House (or sign) brings an idealistic nature to the way that you jointly interact with the world. You may achieve much together in helping others. On the other hand, you may also experience some degree of confusion regarding this relationship or your role within it. You benefit when you make an extra effort to understand what you are trying to accomplish together and stay on top of your responsibilities to each other and with the world around you. In a romantic context, this relationship has some very high ideals, and perhaps illusions, associated with your joint interaction. You each have an idealistic streak that carries over into the way you see yourselves in relationship with each other, while others may not be able to understand what's going in your relationship at all. You may find that it helps to clarify your mutual goals and to stay open to the idea you to have come together to respond to a joint calling. On the positive side, you have the potential within your relationship to express the highest ideals of society. You may collaborate at a professional level on spiritual or healing modalities. At any rate, you enjoy giving more than receiving when it comes to shared service or mutual employment.

Composite Neptune in Pisces (or the twelfth house) brings to your partnership a sensitive, compassionate and loving energy. Your relationship is likely to bring out the idealistic and self-sacrificing side of each of you. You are very sensitive to each other's feelings and frames of mind, and are likely to connect in a multidimensional way. You may find in your connection an element of fantasy or perhaps escapism, because Neptune is more at home here than anywhere else in the chart, since it rules Pisces and the twelfth house, the place where fantasies and dreams naturally live. In a romantic relationship, this placement indicates that you two have the capacity to evoke each other's secrets and fantasies and to fulfill each other's dreams. Your sensitivity to each other's moods and inclinations can go a long way towards building a strong attachment between you, where you dwell in your own secret garden, although there may be a hidden or even a deceptive side to the feelings of affection that naturally come up between you. As a partnership, you benefit from focusing your energies on being of true service to the world, and helping to move it closer to your shared vision of spiritual union for all sentient beings.

Composite Uranus in Aries (15° Ari 41') **Composite Uranus in the Eleventh House**

Uranus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter unusual and unexpected circumstances and where the relationship benefits from lack of structure.

Uranus in the Eleventh House (or sign) brings an eclectic and forward-looking orientation to your shared goals and group affiliations. This is a natural placement for Uranus and brings out the most positive manifestation of this uniquely oriented energy, and your relationship is likely to be idealistic and unconventional. As a partnership, you tend to associate yourselves with friends and groups having as their goal the betterment of society. In a romantic connection, you have a solid basis of friendship, and you can spend a lot of time together without stagnating. Your relationship has high entertainment value and long standing durability based on the

excitement of shared ideas. Your challenge may be to find an equally close emotional connection with each other. Because this is the most changeable of planetary energies, your relationship goals and group affiliations will constantly migrate into new patterns. You may also experience some ups and downs with group participation under stress, although you have a tendency to bounce back from any downside fairly quickly. Together you have a strong urge for personal freedom, and love to explore new horizons together. Your highest mission is to make available to others, through collective action, the progressive ideals for social reform that you cultivate as a partnership.

Composite Uranus in Aries (or the first house) gives your relationship an original and eccentric nature. Working together, you move from a place of powerful and intuitive vision, perhaps more so than working separately. Change and variety excite you as a partnership and may in fact be essential. Your mutability and habit of constantly changing can frustrate or confuse those around you, but it represents a fresh approach and in the end they may thank you for it. In a romantic connection, you two are likely to be known as a couple for your nonconformity. This energy you share can be insensitive to others' needs, and you can appear to be cold at times, or you may seem to be more excited by ideas than by each other. You may each feel the need to constantly assert your independence, so that in this relationship you need space from each other as well as closeness, and it may prove difficult to balance these opposing factors. When you can accept your mutual desire for freedom as an important part of the relationship equation, you go a long way toward solving this basic dilemma. Composite Chiron in Pisces (7° Pis 08') **Composite Chiron in the Tenth House**

Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.

Chiron in the Tenth House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding your vital force to act with authority and make a responsible contribution to society. In this relationship, you may find yourself somewhat rebellious of authority, while compulsively drawn to it at the same time. You may begin to be aware of experiences in your life where you had to knuckle under against your will or, conversely, where felt you had to over-exert your authority with others in a way that left them feeling oppressed. Perhaps the compulsion to be in authority that you are feeling in this relationship arose in your childhood, from a time when you were too forcefully controlled. Everyone has a basic need to be in control, and if we develop a distrust of authority as a result of early experiences, we tend to strike first rather than wait to be pushed around. These unconscious patterns can also manifest in the relationship as a penchant to achieve, only to feel ambivalent about subsequent success. This

relationship may mirror ways that you felt pushed to success by the important parental figures of your childhood, without getting a chance to find your own true destiny. You may experience low self-esteem, seeking notoriety as a way of making up for feelings of worthlessness that live somewhere below your conscious level of reasoning. In order to avoid these traps, it is good to take advantage of this relationship to get in conscious touch with your hidden feelings, and bring them into the light to explore them in detail. Once you have begun this process, it will continue as a natural part of your shared growth, allowing you both to wield a more conscious and integrated form of personal power as you move through the world together.

Composite Chiron in Pisces (or the Twelfth House) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for you both to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding your vital force to be at home in the world of physical manifestation. In this relationship, you may notice places where you feel alienated from rest of mankind, and more at home in a world of fantasy than in what you laughably call "the real world". Talents may arise that come from beyond this world, and you may discover renewed passion for music, poetry, or spirituality. You may be reminded of painful episodes from early childhood that drove you into a world of your own. You have likely come to be quite at home in your inner world, and your challenge is to take advantage of this relationship to come out with style and dignity, with your inner cosmos intact. Again and again, when you attempt to be a part of it all, just like everyone else, you find it doesn't quite work. You may work with other people, helping them to be peaceful and comfortable in connecting their own lives to a higher truth, without ever really getting it yourself. Of course one is tempted to blame oneself for this sort of failure to connect. However, if you can examine the deep emotions associated with withdrawal from the world you can begin to operate from a feeling of wholeness that leads you to make your own true way. As you get in touch with the part of yourself that has been carefully hidden away, defended from the pressures of consensus reality, you can come to a sense of peace with your darker, more hidden self. As your relationship matures in this process of integration, you will both find a way to be a part of the world at large, to participate and share in its wonders and its disasters, without giving anything up. This difficult transformation is vital to your emotional health and well being, and makes it possible for you both to eventually reach out to others as well and help them integrate their shadows into similar wholeness.

Composite Moon in Pisces (22° Pis 49' 48") **Composite Moon in the Eleventh House**

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

The composite Moon in the Eleventh House symbolizes a relationship with a natural level of love and trust between you and strong ideals. You work well as a team, with an emphasis on shared values. Your vision of your future is likely to agree on nearly all points with your partner's, and you respond to each other with a high degree of unselfishness. The very nature of this partnership is accepting and undemanding. In

a romantic relationship, you are generally very loyal and willing to oblige your partner's needs with intrinsic liking for each other. There can be a sense of idealization surrounding the mutual connection that you have with each other, with an easy ability to find intrinsic value in each other, which is great for maintaining a friendship in the midst of romance although you may tend to show up in a less affectionate and more impersonal way for each other. As a partnership you may find yourselves involved at the very center of your circle of friends or groups that you favor. You give yourselves easily to the group effort, and may need to pull back at times from over-involvement.

The composite Moon in Pisces symbolizes a relationship that needs a great deal of sensitivity and compassion to provide a sense of emotional security. Your relationship tends to exhibit a sweet and gentle nature. It brings out a visionary and poetic sentiment, and you two generally are very attuned to spiritual values. You tend to be compassionate and empathetic, and even psychic, with each other and as a partnership with those around you. In a romantic context, your relationship finds itself quite at home in the realms of dreams, fantasies, and visioning. In spite of your individual approaches to life, together you tend to react to the cruelties and unkindness of the world through sensitivity, withdrawal and perhaps escape. It is very important that as you merge together, you share your feelings honestly with each other, thereby remaining true to yourselves, and to the process of getting in touch with your inner worlds. As a partnership, you have great sympathy for the downtrodden and disadvantaged. You may experience some suffering together, through your emotions, especially if your needs are not being met. You also have a mutual tendency to be easily swayed by others. At your best, you two bring spiritual understanding and the gift of your sympathy to your fellow-beings.

Composite Venus in Gemini (2° Gem 14')
Composite Venus in the Twelfth House
Angular planet - conjunct Ascendant

The placement of Venus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared emotional focus and love and where mutual enjoyment and benefit lies.

Venus in the Twelfth House (or sign) indicates that your relationship has a mystical component and a concealed side to it along with appreciation for the subtle and otherworldly. With this placement there are likely to be veiled or perhaps secret undercurrents of emotion that form the basis of your feelings for each other. This is not likely to be a straightforward and openly affectionate relationship that you share, but rather one with some hidden component that you may not even consciously be aware of. In a romantic relationship, you may have a world of your own where you like to hang out together. You are more subject than most couples to the force of your unconscious drives and this relationship can therefore be an excellent one for self-discovery. It is also possible that there may be some element of escapism, or that one of the two of you may be deceived in some way, whether intentionally or not. You can also be very self-sacrificing with each other, which can help preserve the relationship, but which you must be careful does not turn into martyrdom of any kind. It is important to become as conscious as you can of the underlying motivation

for your connection with each other and for your own behavior. As a partnership you have the ability to go to subtle realms and secret depths with each other, and are naturally tuned to higher planes of reality than the physical. This relationship can provide a deep and satisfying glimpse into the depths of your being, once you navigate the potential drawbacks of the situation.

Composite Venus in Gemini (or the third house) indicates a relationship where discourse is valued between you. You appreciate written and spoken communication, both between you and with others in your circle, as well as the literary arts. Whatever your ages, you also may jointly reflect a lively curiosity about the world around you that is the best part of being young. In a romantic relationship, you take delight in conversation together. You appreciate each other's intellect, and find that a significant part of the appeal for each of you. You tend to look on the bright side, and you probably like to laugh with each other, which is obviously an important component of any longterm relationship. As a partnership, you are interested in the pursuits of mental recreation, including computer graphics, puzzles, and the written word. Your good communication with each other ensure that you will at least try to get the best out of every situation that you find yourselves in.

Composite Mercury in Sagittarius (21° Sag 42')
Composite Mercury in the Seventh House
Ruler of Rising Sign

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

The composite Mercury in the Seventh House indicates a relationship with good communication. You naturally gravitate in discussion to where the relationship is going, and how to get there, and remain for the most part in total agreement on ways and means. This is obviously a great placement for any kind of partnership , and especially good for a marriage or romantic pairing. You will run into few misunderstandings regarding priorities. While you do not necessarily think alike, your ability to tell your side of the story to each other makes for a harmonious blending of opinion, since you not only understand each other but also have the mutual desire to be as one mind as far as any decisions that affect your partnership are concerned . As a team you are likely to be friendly and social with other people, preferring open discussion to keeping your own council. This is not a secretive placement and you might want to remind yourselves of that if the need for confidentiality ever arises. As a partnership you make a good public relations or teaching team and have the verbal and written tools at your disposal to influence the opinion of others around you.

Composite Mercury in Sagittarius brings a keen-witted and idealistic mentality to your relationship. Together, you have great powers of logic and deduction, though your shared thought process may also be somewhat scattered. You are likely to be very direct in thought and expression with each other and those around you and will say exactly what is on your mind in as many variations as your audiences will allow.

This gives you and your partner a reputation for great veracity, and perhaps a lack of tact. You also may find that communication in this relationship can leave you impatient or with a tendency to jump to conclusions. You two often visualize the grand possibility and center your perceptions on the larger issue, rather than on the boring details. Your joint thought process is best suited for advocating your position on a particular topic and for generating enthusiastic overviews. You make a good teaching team. You benefit when you take a step back and work individually, or bring in others before making a determination or a commitment. In your partnership you represent the Johnny Appleseeds of communication, offering each other and the world an air of positive enthusiasm for life's many possibilities.

Composite Saturn in Taurus (28° Tau 15') **Composite Saturn in the Twelfth House**

Saturn in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter limitations and build long-lasting success through trials of accomplishment.

Saturn in the Twelfth House (or sign) makes for an odd match, bringing a blockage or a concentration of energy to a power that is as vast and diffuse as the ocean itself. There may be a strong sense of hidden emotional currents between you that will bear further exploration in order to bring them to more conscious awareness. You also may find that you possess a joint focus on the mystical side of life. In a romantic relationship, you may trigger in each other, or help elucidate in each other, the feeling that life is too hard, or that it is beyond your conscious control. You two can be moody and introspective together, or simultaneously compassionate and sympathetic to each other's problems, and to the problems of those who cross your path. In the context of this relationship, you possess in concentrated form the urge for spiritual evolution that is present in all of us, and which requires detachment from the personal self in the quest for mystic union with all mankind. You seek stability in unusual ways with this placement, through the mastery of detaching from a need to rely on convention. You might to watch for a shared tendency to lapse into resignation or conversely, to try too hard to achieve control. Your true path of your partnership lies in a journey toward mystical transcendence rather than in the more mundane life of worldly events.

Composite Saturn in Taurus (or the second house) brings out in this relationship a deepening focus on security issues and the material aspects of life. There may be an overemphasis on the material as well as a feeling of blockage there. If you deal with joint finances, you may each feel limitation and eventual bonding around this subject matter. In a romantic relationship, your shared focus on your financial picture makes for a difficult but sustaining road to travel. Eventually a livable and workable solution will emerge. Along the way, it helps to lighten up. As a partnership, you may be drawn to managing investments for others. Your focus and mutual interest makes for an achievement orientation in this area. You also may transition from a superficial idea of the value of possessions to a deeper one based on true utility. This relationship could also bring up issues around self-worth. One of the main lessons in this relationship for each of you is to discover your individual true inner

worth, in terms of character, high standards, and service to others. From this base, you can together slowly and steadily acquire the material things that best reflect this sense of value as you evolve.

Composite Pluto in Capricorn (12° Cap 01') **Composite Pluto in the Eighth House**

Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

Pluto in the Eighth House (or sign) gives a relationship with a focus on powerful emotions that arise between you, and on behaviors of dominance and self-reliance. You may have strong desires in the context of this relationship and find that you are single-minded about pursuing them. You seem to feel more deeply when you are together, and you may have an almost psychic awareness of each other's energy. In a romantic involvement, boundary related issues are likely to come up between you, reflected in passionate sexuality, deep and powerful feelings of intimacy and questioning where one stops and the other begins. You may also exhibit compulsive behavior around sex and emotional closeness, or be forced to contend with a habit of insisting to get your own way. All these issues will likely become transformed in the course of your shared life together. This relationship's very survival may depend on how deeply you are each able to concentrate your attention on personal transformation as a result of working through your issues with each other. As a partnership, you may also exhibit a tendency to manipulate others for your own purposes. In order to grow, both of you need to turn away from manipulating others and use your power to regenerate your own lives. You win when you learn to empower each other and enable each other's self-reliance, and when you realize that you have come together for purposes of healing.

Composite Pluto in Capricorn (or the tenth house) brings a survival instinct to the relationship with a focus on issues of authority, power and control. You may be very conscious of a sense of purpose that has brought you together, and there may be power dynamics at play between you so that one of you attempts, perhaps unconsciously, to control the other. This can manifest as one or both of you playing parent and/or rebel with the other at times. In a more conscious way of relating, this placement can manifest in an exploration of the nature of authority and judgment as it arises in your relationship. In a romantic context, you may need to balance your desire to be an important part of the social world with your shared need for a deep, emotional private life. You may have the opportunity with this relationship to liberate yourselves from longstanding karmic power patterns that reside in each of you. It benefits you to create a container where you feel safe to open up and be vulnerable, and to explore and get at the very root of the fear or the hurt that drives you toward controlling behavior or dependency. When you feel safe with each other, you can use play or sexuality to work out your power issues in a more conscious way. This relationship is calling you both to transform your urge for power and control to a more conscious and socially responsible use of personal power.

The composite Rising Sign is the image that this partnership presents to others and characterizes the nature of the relationship.

Composite Mars in strong opposition (fading, 1.5 degrees) with Ascendant Leading planet of planetary pattern

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between Composite Mars and Ascendant signifies a relationship that is energetic, active and outgoing. You may find that as a unit you are more confident and accomplishment oriented than as individuals. You have a strong sense of yourselves as a partnership, and are likely to make some waves when you put your heads together. You may have an excess of outgoing initiative that is obvious to others around you. Since there is intense willpower at your disposal in this relationship, you must find a useful outlet for all that energy or you will turn it on each other in unnecessary arguments. Composite Jupiter in quintile (fading, 1.0 degrees) with Ascendant Focal planet of planetary pattern

This aspect between Composite Jupiter and Ascendant signifies an optimistic and growth-oriented relationship, with high ideals and good vitality. As a partnership, you are spiritually motivated, and possess a quiet strength which is invariably helpful to others and which takes you far in the world. This is an excellent aspect for success especially in a business relationship, or in a romantic relationship or friendship that has an additional career orientation. As a partnership, you might only have to guard against being overly optimistic at times, for your enthusiasm for life takes you far.

Composite Neptune in square (forming, 2.8 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between Composite Neptune and Ascendant signifies a highly sensitive, visionary and creative relationship. Your partnership may well be founded on principles of an artistic or musical nature, and you are likely to be sensitive to each other to an extraordinary degree. Composite Pluto in inconjunct (fading, 2.4 degrees) with Ascendant

This aspect between Composite Pluto and Ascendant signifies a transformative and depth-oriented relationship. Your connection has its dark moments, but is fundamental in energizing your lives and allowing you to move through some very significant issues together. You are likely to be engaged in some form of power struggle with each other in this relationship, which can be difficult to handle gracefully, but which can also be a blessing in bringing up the hidden places within each of you and exposing them to the light of conscious awareness. evolve in your understanding of yourselves and each other. Composite Chiron in square (forming, 2.5 degrees) with Ascendant

This aspect between Composite Chiron and Ascendant signifies a relationship with a great deal of healing potential. One or both of you are likely to experience painful realizations through the agency of this relationship that will enable you to recognize and eventually heal important issues that you face. Composite Venus in weak conjunction (forming, 7.4 degrees) with Ascendant

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

For friends there will be acceptance and affection between you, whereas in a business connection a strong friendship component is indicated. Composite Sun in strong trine (fading, 2.1 degrees) with Uranus

With this aspect between composite Sun and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and uniquely idealistic quality. This aspect indicates an independent and strong-willed relationship. You two are determined to do things your own way, and love freedom from conformity. Together, you tend to explore all things new and unusual as a matter of course. You don't have to go out of your way to find them; they tend to find you first. You likely support each other to start new projects, or make major changes in your lives, and you share the gift of transforming yourselves without completely eliminating previous foundations. The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This placement gives your relationship strong communication skills. There may be a shared delight in mental pursuits. You two naturally understand each other's heads and hearts, and often know what the other person is saying even before they have finished saying it.

**Composite Sun in trine
(forming, 4.9 degrees) with Jupiter
Focal planet of planetary pattern**

This aspect between composite Sun and Jupiter indicates an optimistic and generous relationship filled with good spirits and abundant energy. Together, you tend to approach life in a quietly spiritual way. You share good executive abilities, and when working together make capable leaders. **Composite Sun in sextile
(forming, 3.8 degrees) with Midheaven**

This is a great placement for business partnerships and for friendships with a mutual goal in mind. **Composite Moon in strong square
(fading, 1.1 degrees) with Mercury
Ruler of Rising Sign**

This aspect between composite Moon and Mercury brings a verbally expressive and creative quality to your relationship, and also may indicate that the thinking and feeling functions between you have a tendency to clash. This aspect between composite Moon and Jupiter gives your relationship an optimistic and emotionally nurturing quality. You tend to see the best in each other and in the ideas you share, serving as both cheerleaders for each other's process and teammates working toward a shared goal. **Composite Moon in sextile
(forming, 5.4 degrees) with Saturn**

With this aspect between composite Moon and Saturn, your relationship has a responsible, centered and hard-working basis that also might be experienced as a blockage of emotional connection between you. With this aspect, you may provide each other with the right blend of encouragement and stability to make each of your own lives happen. Composite Moon in semi-sextile (fading, 1.2 degrees) with Midheaven

You likely prefer a simple mode of life and possess a good balance between the spiritual and physical realms. You benefit from developing these joint gifts, and sharing them with each other and with loved ones, and with the world around you.

Composite Mercury in strong sextile (fading, 0.1 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

With this aspect between composite Mercury and the Midheaven, your relationship has a strong mental focus with the potential for many and varied conversations. You may have come together to practice some form of communication oriented business venture. You undoubtedly have a strong communication orientation in your relationship, and likely converse well on many topics together. In a romantic relationship you may feel the need to balance your head with your heart. The excellent communication that you share will compensate for many difficulties, but a strong emotional basis must also be an important component of your shared connection. As a team you have a terrific ability to reach out verbally to the world outside your partnership, either in spoken or written form, with a restless curiosity that touches on many subjects. Composite Mercury in bi-septile (forming, 1.2 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies darkly interact; incline to occult dimensions apart from socially accepted norms.

Other Natal Planets

Composite N Node in Aries (5° Ari 45') Composite N Node in the Eleventh House

Lunar North Node in the Eleventh House (or sign). South Node in the fifth house or sign. This placement in a composite chart signifies that within this relationship you each have an emphasis on friendships, group associations and social goals. Although creativity on a personal level comes easily to you, and creating by means of

including other people is perhaps more difficult, it is to this more difficult task that you are drawn in the context of this relationship. In the past, you may have felt a great deal of pride in your individuality and individual contribution. Other Aspects

Composite Jupiter in strong opposition (fading, 1.0 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Jupiter and the Midheaven brings a joyful recognition between you and good luck generally, although with a perhaps overly optimistic assessment of your potential. You two may feel like you can move mountains together, and you might need to be aware of the possibility of glossing over the drawbacks along the way to a proposed outcome. It may be best to temper your joyful expectations with a healthy dose of pessimism and reality checking. In a romantic relationship, you are likely to be excited over your plans for a shared future. You might want to be sure that you're on course before you go ahead with your plans. You also may have a joint urge for taking in the broader point of view

that comes with extended travel, while teaching and learning together are also likely to be a strong part of your relationship experience.

Composite Neptune in strong conjunction (fading, 0.3 degrees) with Chiron

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this aspect in your composite chart you have in your relationship a strong spiritual connection and an almost psychic sympathy with each other, based on your own experiences in these sensitive areas. One or both of you is likely to have particularly strong access to the world of dreams and inner fantasy, which may serve as an escape valve. If so, there may be a wound to your sense of place in this physical world. You may be extremely sensitive to the energy of others, and vicariously experience their pain, or allow yourself to be overly influenced by their opinion of you. Something perhaps keeps you out of touch with consensus reality, and you are not very comfortable with this role. With this placement you may notice you don't get what you want from your partner in the short run. Especially in a romantic relationship, obstacles tend to crop up on your joint path having to do with distance, age, lack of availability or the like, making it difficult for you get to where you want to go with each other. This aspect between composite Venus and Uranus brings to your relationship an eccentric and unconventional method of relating to each other, with a unique ability to come together in new ways. In a romantic context, you may act unpredictably at times, making it hard for you and others to feel stable and comfortable around your relationship. You may have difficulty, for example, settling down into the nuts and bolts of partnership with each other. Your potential with each other is quite variable, making it hard to know exactly where this relationship is headed. You benefit from attempting to bring a steady and consistent focus to your many interests and activities together, and when you allow space for your shared need for freedom.

Composite Venus in sextile (forming, 3.5 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Composite Mars in semi-sextile (forming, 0.8 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

With this aspect between composite Mars and Pluto, your relationship has a passionate intensity and also the potential for conflict. There is a powerful connection between you based around the concept of self-assertion, either yours or your partner's, and one reason that you have come together at this time is to attempt to heal this issue in your lives. In a romantic connection, your sexual magnetism and activity is likely to be strong, as well as issues of power and control that are likely to crop up between you. The pattern of your relationship may be such that one of you appears timid or unsure to the other partner much of the time, since the power urge when problematic commonly hides deep underground, but there is the potential for sudden bursts of anger when repressed emotion finally finds its way to the surface. Composite Mars in square (fading, 4.1 degrees) with Chiron

**Composite Sun in weak conjunction
(fading, 6.6 degrees) with Mars**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

Glossary

Ascendant: The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects: When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

Conjunction — $0^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Square — $90^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Opposition — $180^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Sextile — $60^{\circ} \pm 6$ degrees

Trine — $120^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Inconjunct — $150^{\circ} \pm 4$ degrees

Chart Comparison: An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart: An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope: Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."

Midheaven: The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.

Natal: From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.

Nodes: The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.

Planets: In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.

Transits: Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
